

Antique Decoys

General guidelines

1. Entries can be inspired by decoys from the past but must be the carvers interpretation of an "old" decoy.
2. Decoys should be made to look old by the manner in which they are carved and finished.
3. Decoys should be functional, durable and able to withstand the hard use of hunting.
4. The decoy must be "antique" in style and appearance.
5. The decoys will not be floated.

Entries will be grouped into four classes

- A. Marsh Ducks
- B. Diving Ducks
- C. Geese, Swans and Confidence Decoys
- D. Shorebirds

Ribbons

First, Second and Third in each of the four classes
First, second and third Best of Show.

Cash Awards
